What I Evaluate

Appendix A: Species Accuracy Assessment

A concise species-by-species review of anatomical, behavioural, and ecological realism.

- Anatomical proportions and soft-tissue plausibility
- Movement, feeding, and social behaviour
- Time-period and geographic alignment
- Simple visual notes for anatomical or behavioural corrections
- Individual species accuracy ratings contributing to the overall Dinosaur Accuracy Score (40%)

Initial Project Overview

Understanding the audit's purpose, the attraction or scene being evaluated, its narrative intent, and the audience and experience it is designed for.

Why This Matters

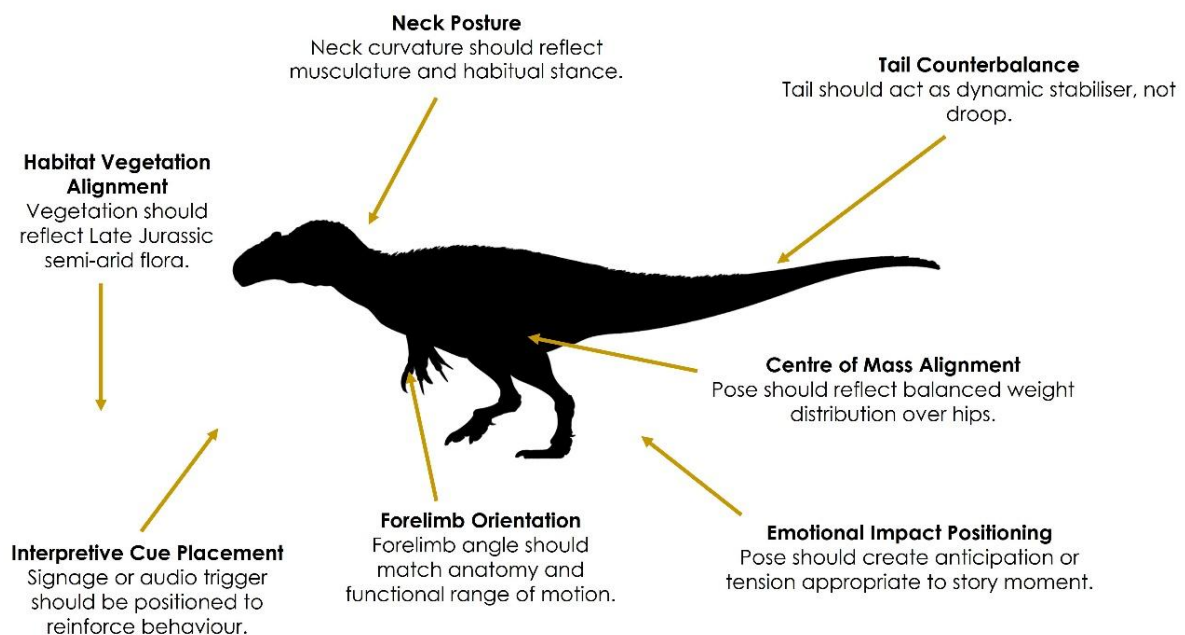
